The Alentejo Marmòris & Spa Hotel is also the perfect place for weddings and christenings. It has capacity for a banquet until 150 people.

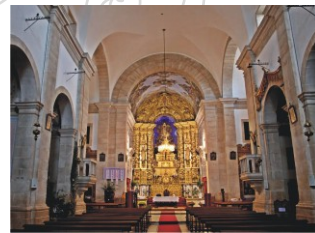
For the religious ceremony, we inform you that has the Church of St. Bartholomew at 5 minutes walk from the Hotel, on the main square of Vila Viçosa.

There's also the option of the Nossa Senhora da Conceição church, which is a 5-minute drive from the Hotel, within the walls of the castle of Vila Viçosa.

Church of St Bartholomew in Vila Viçosa.

Church founded in 1636, exemplary of seventeenth-century architecture, with a Latin cross plan, single nave with side chancel, transept and chapels wide.

The latter presents coverage barrel vault and coated elevations of blue and white tiles , highlighting the great altarpiece of gilt, with throne and also gilded wooden tabernacle. The choir consists of three round arches with balustrade. The side chapels are dedicated to Santa Quitéria, Santa Ana, Blessed Sacrament, Our Lady of the Rosary, Our Lady of Solitude and Our Lady of Health. Noteworthy were the gilded woodwork and decorated in fresh paintings or tile panels.

Is also known as Patroness, Solar by it to meet the image of [Nossa Senhora da Conceição](#), patron saint of Portugal.

The church, which is both Mother of [Viçosa Village](#), is situated inside the medieval walls of the castle of the village, and we can not yet specify the exact date of its foundation, the existence of the array is already signaled in medieval times. The results of the present building reform carried out in 1569, reigning King [D. Sebastião](#), with a large temple with three naves, where the local marble predominates as material used in construction. Façade divided into three spans , each of which opens a simple gantry squared frame loaded by simple triangular pediment cornice. On each gate, is a rectangular picture window frame of deep chamfer . The facade is divided by pilasters and the building flanked by solid square tower. It has three naves and five spans of round arches on Doric columns. Inside the church, highlights the coating polychrome tiles.
